Directions to Kingsmead Centre:

Directions from M5:

- Exit at junction 26
- At the roundabout take the exit signposted Wellington A38



- At the next roundabout turn left onto the A38 southbound



- At the next roundabout continue on the A38
- After approximately 2 miles you will see a turning to the left signposted Ford Street, Hemyock and Chard, there are also brown tourist signs for The Merry Harriers pub

- Turn left and proceed up through Ford Street until you come to the crossroads at the top of the hill and a signpost for Kingsmead Centre
- Turn left following the sign



- After about 2 miles you will see the site of the former Merry Harriers pub on the right hand side and a sign for Kingsmead Centre.



- Turn right following the sign.
- The entrance to the site is about ¼ mile down this road on the left

Directions from A303:

- Just before (or after if travelling from the South West) Honiton you will come to a large junction named Eagle Cross (marked by a large road sign and the Eagle Tavern Pub)

- Turn off the A303 following the signs for Wellington and Taunton (a right hand turn if travelling towards the South West)



- Proceed along this road for approximately four miles until you come to a crossroads

- Carry on straight over the crossroads
- You will come to a double T-Junction



- Bear right – you will pass The Holman Clavel Pub on your left
- You will shortly come to another crossroads



- Carry on straight over this crossroads
- After approximately 3 miles you will see site of the former Merry Harriers pub on your left and a signpost for Kingsmead Centre



- **N.B. The pub building shown in google street view is no longer there**
- Turn left
- The entrance to the site is about ¼ mile down this road on the left
